Identified Improvement Targets in Progress

- The leadership team has held two video conference meetings with Rose Colby, author of "Competency- Based Education" which is our staff wide reading assignment. The book contains a rich presentation of key educational components for our staff to discuss, as we move toward competency based education in the high school. She will now address our full faculty on Competency Based Education on Tuesday December 12th.

Student & Staff Accomplishments

- KHS was invited to participate for the first time in the 'I am College Bound/I Applied' program. New Hampshire's "***I Am College Bound/I Applied***" campaign is designed to help high school seniors navigate the college admissions process and ensure that each student pursues a post-secondary education by inviting them to submit at least one college admission application. Each participating high school receives one \$500 scholarship to be raffled and awarded to a participating student. This campaign is part of the, a national effort to increase the number of first-generation and low-income students pursuing a college degree or other higher education credential. The Kennett college bound results; 36 students participated, **81** applications submitted to NH schools and **\$3,805.00** saved in application fees.
