Expectations for Students, Parents and Teachers

Please review this information about exams. Please zero in on rules and procedures, including the following:

Unless excused by the principal or career-tech director, all students are required to be present during the scheduled exam time. Students may take portions of their midterm or final assessments prior to the exam date. However, at least some part of their assessment (e.g. reflective essay, self evaluation, course evaluation, etc.) must be completed during the scheduled exam period.

No students are allowed to enter an exam late. Late students must schedule a time to retake the exam at the convenience of the instructor with permission from the principal.

Stick to the schedule and do not allow students to leave early.

Students are not allowed to leave the room during an exam unless there is a dire emergency.

Be careful about the noise level in your room since others nearby may be working in complete silence.

Attendance is taken in exams each period and sent to the Vice Principal's Office.... Only report students absent that are supposed to be in the exam. If you made arrangements for the student to take the exam at another time, do not mark them absent.

Some students will use the break to study for an exam and might arrive for class early.

Be prepared to schedule a time for a make-up exam if a student is absent.

In semester courses, the exam counts for 10% of the final grade if a midterm was given and 20% if no midterm was given. As a privilege, seniors who have an "A" (90 and above) average in a course during the second semester (Q3 and Q4 grades will be used to determine the average in both year long and semester courses) can opt to have the course final exam waived.

During study times, students may report to the cafeteria or gym (where socialization will be permitted) or the library where quiet study will be required.

Students are allowed to leave the building after they are done with their exams for the day.

Bus Schedule:

11:40 am – ALL students should plan to leave at this time unless they have made prior arrangements with a teacher or will stay for quiet study in the library

2:20 pm– only available for any student who stayed at school to study with a teacher
